



Frisco Family Services Center Back to School Program 2009



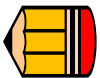

We will be providing school supplies, new clothing, new shoes and hygiene items for approximately 500 needy children in Frisco. This can be a great project in which you can truly make a difference in the community!

Here is how you can help:



Pick a Child from the Apple Tree:

Provide a child with a **new** back-to-school outfit and shoes.
You will receive a paper apple tag that will have the child's gender, age, clothing size and shoe size.



Host a school supply or hygiene/pampering item drive:

Collect school supplies and/or hygiene items from the provided lists.



Make a cash contribution to the program:

If you don't have the time to go out and shop for clothes or supplies, let us do the shopping for you.



Volunteer:

Volunteer your time in sorting school supplies, clothing, etc... (Last week of July thru August)
